Spring Camp April 4-6, 2014

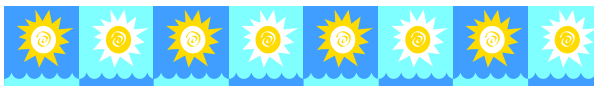

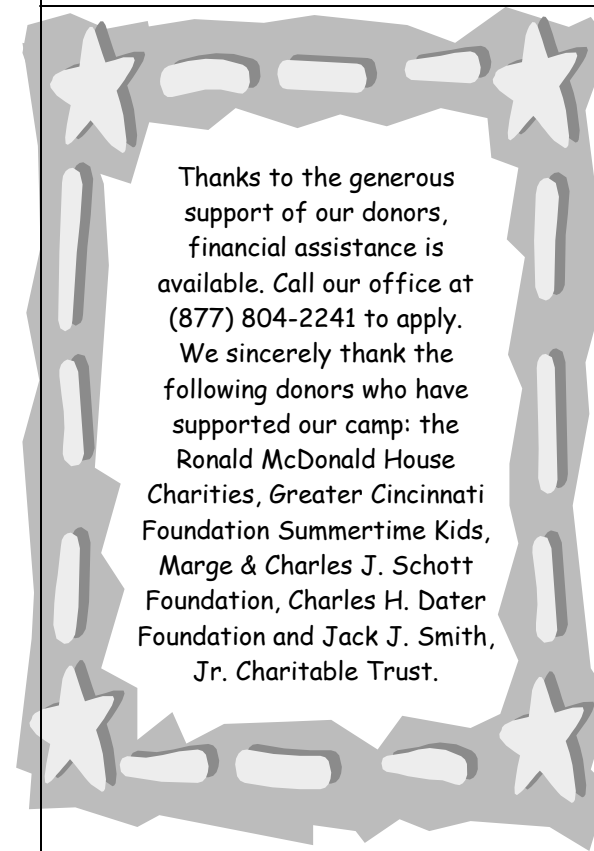
Cost is minimal and includes food and activities. Don't delay—space is limited for this special camp for campers of **ALL** ages!
