Epilepsy

Epilepsy is a neurological condition caused by sudden brief changes in the brain's electrical balance. When there are excess electrical discharges in the brain, seizures occur. It is not a disease, but a symptom of an underlying neurological disorder. This disturbance affects the brain's normal functions and produces changes in a person's movement, behavior or consciousness. Epilepsy is not a disease, mental illness or a sign of low intelligence. It is not contagious. Epilepsy is generally a chronic and/or lifelong condition.

There are at least 30 types of seizures. An Institute on Medicine report released the fact that 1 in 26 people will develop epilepsy at some point in their life.
