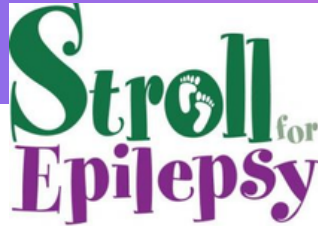


The Update

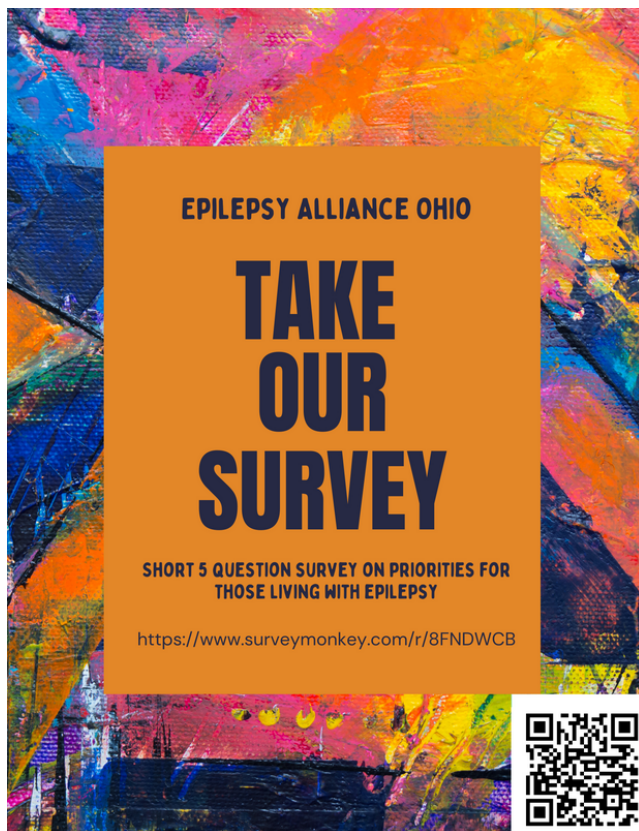

Scholarship Roundup

Taylor Huth Memorial Scholarship Program

A college scholarship fund set up by the family and friends of Benjamin "Taylor" Huth to remember and celebrate Taylor's zeal and love for life.

The Taylor Huth Memorial Scholarship Award is a one year, \$2,000 Scholarship honoring local, outstanding students who have overcome or are working to overcome the challenges of epilepsy.

Deadline is March 29, 2024

The Charles L. Shor Epilepsy Empowerment Fund provides direct educational assistance to individuals diagnosed with epilepsy including scholarships to universities, colleges, technical training and certification programs, and financial assistance for students enabling them to attend and complete the educational program.

Deadline is March 15, 2024

UCB Family Epilepsy Scholarship Program

In 2024, UCB will award 30 scholarships of up to \$5,000 and 3 scholarships of up to \$10,000 to people living with epilepsy, their family members, and caregivers pursuing higher education.
